Competition for Koivukylä Center



The City of Vantaa arranges a planning and plot cessation competition based on partnership planning of Koivukylä center. The aim is to find a high-level architectural entity that boosts Koivukylä's cityscape, sense of community, and improves its services. The competition will take place from August 15 to November 30, 2016.

The main requests are residential and business building as well as a place for a library. The land area near Koivukylä station remains mostly unbuilt and it amounts to 22 000 m². A high-rise residential building is currently situated in the area, but it will be demolished.

Participants shall compile a general land-use plan for Koivukylä center. At least two proposals will be chosen as winners, and the city will continue planning with them. Alternately, only one proposal compiled in cooperation with several actors may be chosen as the winner. In addition to the actual task, the participants shall compile a separate idea plan for Koivutory shopping mall where the area and the building will be reformed while maintaining its present character.

The city will sell the plots to the winner of the competition.
